Can you hear the finches in the berry patch? You never know what you'll find, but one thing is sure – nature never lets you down – there is always something amazing just waiting to be discovered.

Bring a friend or your family and help count birds on 23 idyllic acres of organic farmland at Nanoose Edibles Farm then stop by the market for a chat with the farmers and warm up with a cupa' jo or a bowl of soup made from fresh farm produce. Take home some tasty organic edibles and if you have a young naturalist in your life, think about joining the Young Naturalists Club.
